INTEN OFFICE REJUVENATION

The rejuvenation of a construction company office signalled a new fresh start for the client, with a revamped company logo and branding, our brief was to provide a modern design incorporating the new brand and natural building materials.

Challenges

Our client posed that question, "How can we get our team of 20 onto a single floor plate?"

The original office configuration consisted of various teams (Eg: managers, estimating, projects, admin etc). separated and on different floor levels.

The request was simple but the practical solution was the challenge.

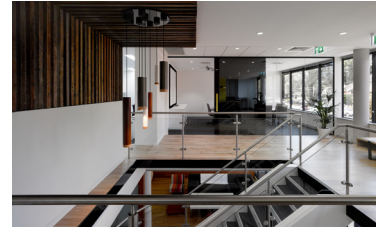
Extending the first level floor plate into & over the warehouse entry was the key driver to obtain the required floor area.

Corner manager offices with direct contact to the teams was important along with an open working and common breakout / kitchen zone.

Approach

During the design phase the development of the open plan reduced the clients need for multiple meeting rooms. While providing one large boardroom for both staff and client use, the introduction of the kitchen / breakout space with a large island bench is also utilized for internal meetings.

The use of open vertical screening elements, assisted in the visual aspect of the open plan, and clients brief of visual connection.



Outcomes

A crisp, fresh, modern workspace, open plan with visual connection throughout and a subtle connection back to the construction nature of the business with some raw materials.
